## Course Description

- + **Anatomy:** Review the different lobes of the brain, cranial nerves, and Circle of Willis.
- + **What is a Stroke?:** Importance of rapid stroke care, difference between ischemic and hemorrhagic strokes, 5 stroke syndromes, risk factors and stroke mimics.
- + **Patient Management – EMS/Triage:** Assessment tools, severity scales, blood pressure, glucose, and oxygen management, and transport decisions.
- + **Stroke Treatment – Hyperacute Phase:** Pre-hospital stroke scales, alert criteria and process, neuro assessment, and treatment options.
- + **Patient Management – First 24 Hours:** Neurologic assessments, swallow screen, and preventing complications.
- + **Patient Management – After 24 Hours:** Neurologic assessments, preventing complications, stroke etiology, patient education, and discharge readiness.
